3 Collection of personal data when visiting our website

(1) In the case of merely informative use of the website, i.e. if you do not register, register or otherwise provide information to us for the use of the website, we will not collect any personal data, with the exception of data transmitted by your browser to our server. If you wish to view our website, we collect the following data that is technically necessary for us to inform you about our website and to ensure the stability and security (legal basis is Art. 6 para. 1 lit. f of the DSGVO):

- IP address
- Date and time of the request
- Time zone difference to Greenwich Mean Time (GMT)
- Content of the request (concrete page)
- Access status / HTTP status code
- Each transferred amount of data
- Website from which the request comes
- Browser
- Operating system and its interface
- Language and version of the browser software.

(2) In addition to the aforementioned data, cookies are stored on your computer when you use our website. Cookies are small text files that are stored on your hard drive assigned to the browser you are using and by which the body that sets the cookie (here through us) receives certain information. Cookies cannot run programs or transmit viruses to your computer. They serve to make the Internet offer more user-friendly and effective overall.

(3) Use of cookies:

- 1. a) This website uses the following types of cookies, the scope and mode of operation, which are explained below:
- Transient cookies (see b)
- Persistent cookies (see c).
- 1. b) Transient cookies are automatically deleted when you close the browser. These include, in particular, the session cookies. These store a so-called session ID, with which various requests from your browser can be assigned to the common session. This will allow your computer to

be recognized when you return to our website. The session cookies are deleted when you log out or close the browser.

6 Web-Analytics
